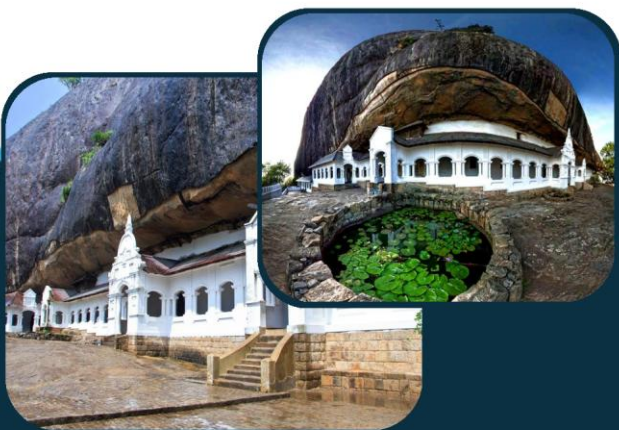



## Day 2

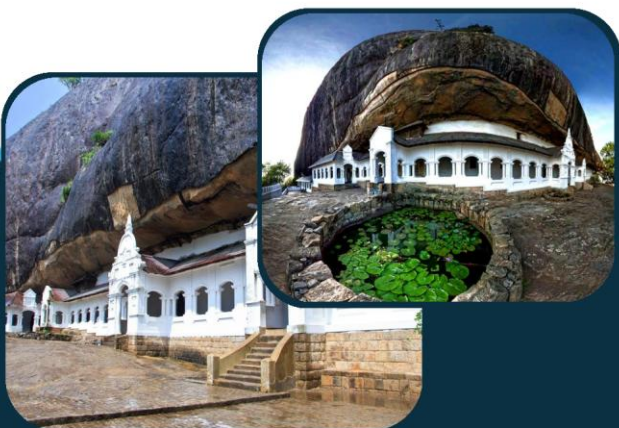

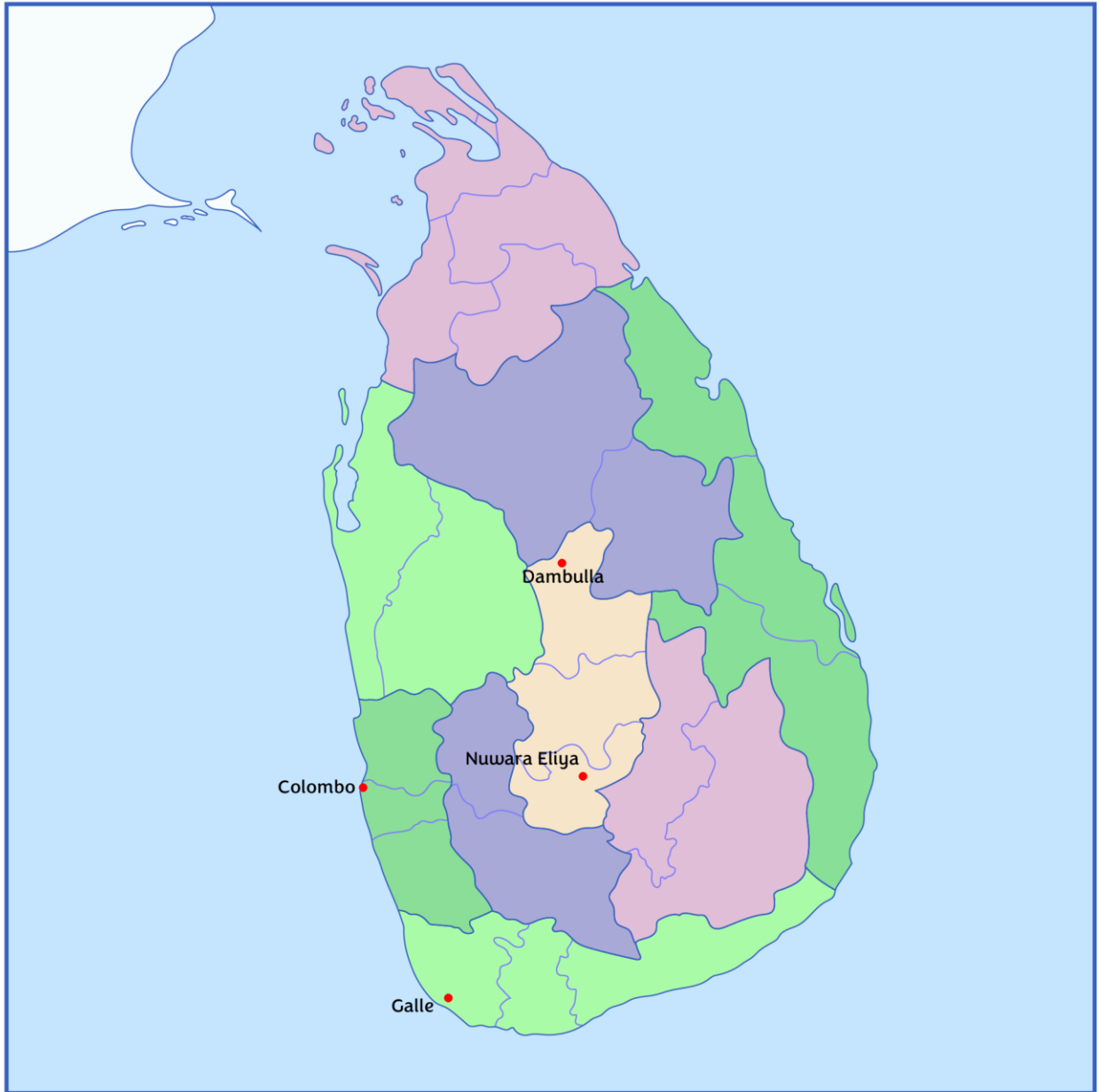
