9 night / 10 days tour.

Day 1 – Arrival in Sri Lanka – Ahungalla

Return to Riu Ahungalla for an overnight stay.

Day 3 - Ahungalla to Nuwara Eliya via Mirissa & Stilt Fishing

After breakfast, the journey heads south along the coastline to **Mirissa**, famous for its palm-fringed beaches. Here, the group will witness the age-old tradition of **stilt fishing**, where fishermen perch gracefully above the waves on slender poles – a rare and captivating sight unique to Sri Lanka. The road then winds inland, climbing into the cool highlands. The scenery shifts from tropical palms to mist-covered hills blanketed with tea plantations. Arriving in **Nuwara Eliya**, often called "Little England" for its colonial charm and cool climate, the group will check in at **Golden Ridge** for the night.

Day 4 - Exploring Nuwara Eliya

After breakfast, the day is spent discovering the beauty of Nuwara Eliya's surroundings. Options include visiting the stunning **Gregory Lake**, walking through the flower-filled

parks, or exploring nearby tea estates to see how world-famous Ceylon tea is produced. The cool air and picturesque setting make it perfect for a leisurely afternoon back at the hotel. Overnight stay at Golden Ridge.

Day 5 - Scenic Train Journey to Peradeniya & Journey to Dambulla

The morning begins with one of Sri Lanka's most famous travel experiences – a **scenic train ride** from Nuwara Eliya's highlands to Peradeniya. The afternoon brings an exhilarating wildlife adventure at **Minneriya National Park**, famed for its large gatherings of wild elephants, especially near the ancient Minneriya Tank. As the sun sets, enjoy a vibrant **cultural dance performance**, showcasing Sri Lankan music, costumes, and traditional drumming. Overnight stay at Amaya Lake.

Day 7 - Sigiriya & Transfer to Colombo

An early start leads to the climb of the legendary **Sigiriya Rock Fortress**, also a UNESCO site. Rising dramatically from the plains, the rock is crowned with the ruins of an ancient royal palace and offers breathtaking panoramic views. Along the way up, admire the famed frescoes and the Mirror Wall. After descending, the journey continues to **Colombo**, Sri Lanka's bustling commercial capital, where the group will check in at the **Sheraton Colombo** for the night.

Day 8 - Colombo City Tour

After breakfast, embark on a **city tour of Colombo**, discovering its fascinating mix of modern skyscrapers, colonial buildings, and colorful street markets. Highlights include the Galle Face Green promenade, Independence Square, and the vibrant Pettah Bazaar. In the evening, guests can enjoy Colombo's lively dining scene before an overnight stay at Sheraton Colombo.
